

Accommodation Suggestions

Conference 2024 - Winchester

The following is a list of possible accommodation. It is provided "as-is", with no guarantee of accuracy, nor any endorsement of any establishment by HBA. HBA has not contacted any of these establishments, and is not receiving any referral fee. The list is provided simply for the convenience of delegates.

There are no hotels in the immediate vicinity of the University.

We have the usual big chains:

- <u>Travelodge</u> in the High Street
- Mercure Winchester Wessex Hotel near the Cathedral
- Premier Inn on the outskirts, near the motorway
- Holiday Inn just outside Winchester to the East (easily accessed from the Motorway, near the Arqiva satellite uplink for the broadcasting geeks!)
- Days Inn at the service areas on the <u>M3 (Winchester Services)</u> and A34 (Sutton Scotney <u>north-and south-bound</u>)

In addition, there are the following hotels (independent/smaller chains):

- Winchester Royal Hotel in the city centre
- Hotel du Vin, in the city centre
- The Old Vine, in the city centre
- Winchester Hotel & Spa, just outside city centre, close to railway station
- <u>Lainston House</u>, to the north, just outside village of Sparsholt for those with deep pockets!
- The Black Hole, just outside city centre, to the east
- The Marwell Hotel, to the south-east, next to Marwell Zoo
- Norton Park Hotel & Spa, to the north, near village of Sutton Scotney

Then there are pubs with rooms:

- The Westgate closest to the University, en route from railway station to University
- Wykeham Arms, in the city centre
- The King Alfred just outside city centre to north
- The Running Horse in village of Littleton, just to the north of the city
- Bugle Inn, in village of Twyford, just to south-east
- <u>Plough Inn</u>, in village of Itchen Abbas to the east
- King's Head in village of Hursley, to the south west
- The Dolphin, in village of Hursley, to the south west
- <u>The Fox</u>, in village of Crawley, to the north (ideal for broadcasting geeks who want to drive past Arqiva's national HQ, one of the UK's main satellite uplink centres!)
- Potter's Heron to the south

In addition, there are further hotels to the south, in the town of Eastleigh (10 minutes from Winchester by train) and at Southampton Airport (also served by rail).
